Direct Support Professional

Job Description

Community Access Services has residential caregiving opportunities (**Direct Support Professional**) in homes serving five individuals with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). These individuals have a variety of medical and physical care needs and require a significant level of supportive care. Responsibilities will include support with daily living activities (hygiene/bathing, personal needs, dressing, eating, transferring to/from a wheelchair, medication administration, light housework, etc.) and accompaniment with community activities. CAS provides person-centered service based on the wants, needs, and choices of the individual receiving service.

We welcome applicants with previous caregiving experience; however, we also welcome those without experience who have a strong interest in helping people (we will provide training).

This position starts at \$14.00/hour. CAS has a part and full-time positions available at our group homes in NE Portland and SE Portland.

Minimum requirements for employment with CAS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be comfortable working in a home where a cat or other pet resides
- Must pass a criminal background check and pre-employment drug screen, cannabis excluded
